Serafin String Quartet Previews 2017-2018 Season

(Wilmington, Del.) July 28, 2017 - <u>Serafin String Quartet</u> announces key performances dates for the 2017-2018 season in New York, Philadelphia, Oklahoma and Florida in addition to regional venues. Based in Delaware, the highly acclaimed Quartet debuted at Carnegie Hall in 2004 and has consistently been sought after for performances around the nation.

The Serafins add first time appearances at Music at the Gate (Queens, N.Y.), From The Edge Music Series (Norman, Okla.), College of Physicians (Philadelphia, Pa.) and St. Paul's Episcopal Church (Delray, Fla.). The Quartet will also return to local series, including Milton Theatre, The Arts at Trinity, World Cafe Live (Philadelphia), and University of Delaware, where the Quartet serves as *Quartet in Residence*.

Serafin String Quartet collaborates in an exchange partnership with Blair String Quartet of <u>Vanderbilt University</u>, featuring master classes and a joint performance at <u>University of Delaware</u> in the fall. The Serafins will perform with other notable artists including Roberta Rust, pianist, (in Fla.); Stephanie Shames, pianist, and Hal Grossman, violinist, (in Okla.); and Julie Coucheron, pianist, and Hal Grossman, violinist (in Del.). The Quartet will share a wide variety of repertoire with audiences in the coming season including works by Barber, Beethoven, Brahms, Chausson, Dvorak, Haydn, Mendelssohn, Mozart, Shostakovich, Sibelius and Still.

About Serafin String Quartet

Hailed for "silken finesse and gritty vibrancy" by *Gramophone Magazine* and for "playing with style and sophistication" by *The Strad Magazine*, Serafin String Quartet debuted at Weill Recital Hall at Carnegie Hall in 2004 and has consistently received superlatives in the press and ovations by audiences around the nation. The Quartet's highly acclaimed Naxos (2013) release featuring world premiere recordings of early chamber works by Pulitzer Prize-winning composer Jennifer Higdon was listed as "Top 10 Classical Albums in 2013" by Philadelphia's City Paper. The Quartet's debut recording on Centaur (2010) is an "American Tapestry" of works by American composers influenced by American sounds, including Barber, Dvorák, Gershwin and William Grant Still. Featured by Strings Magazine for innovative concert programming, Serafin String Quartet has been applauded at performances around the nation. The Quartet serves as Quartet in Residence at the University of Delaware and takes its name from master violin maker, Sanctus Serafin, who in 1728 crafted the violin currently played by SSQ violinist Kate Ransom.
