

Hiroko Yamazaki Bio

Hiroko Yamazaki, piano, has performed in the US and abroad with members of the Tonhalle Orchestra, Philadelphia Orchestra and Delaware Symphony at venues including the Smithsonian, Kennedy Center and Swarthmore College. Festival appearances include Luzerne, Aspen, Rome (Italy) and International Festival Institute at Round Top, Texas (recorded by NPR). She is the pianist for Pyxis Piano Trio, the ensemble in residence at both the Delaware Art Museum and Market Street Music in Wilmington. Ms. Yamazaki has taught at both University of Delaware and Aspen Music Festival and School and is currently Associate Head of the Piano Department/Master Piano Faculty with Special Distinction at The Music School of Delaware. Winner of the Austrian- American Society Competition (which sponsored her studies at Salzburg's Mozarteum), Ms. Yamazaki attended the University of Maryland, receiving a Bachelor of Music in piano performance, the Presser Foundation and Collaborative Piano Awards, and Master of Music in Collaborative Piano.
